أهداف التدريب:

1. **الكلمات والتعبيرات:** أن يمتلك المتدرب مخزون من المفردات والتعبير الجديدة لا يقل عن 500 كلمة جديدة، 300 تعبير جديد.
2. **القواعد:** أن يصبح المتدرب على معرفة جيدة بقواعد النحو والصرف الأساسية المخصصة لهذا المستوى وتوظيفها في تراكيب لغوية متقنه.
3. **القراءة:** أن يمتلك القدرة على قراءة الجمل البسيطة والشائعة مع الاستيعاب بشكل مريح وبلفظ متقن خاصة الكلمات المكونة من 4 حروف وأقل.
4. **الكتابة:** أن يكون قادراً على كتابة جمل قصيرة متقنة قواعديا واملائيا، مع التعبير بشكل واضح عن نفسه وطرح الأسئلة والإجابات البسيطة.
5. **المحادثة والاستماع:** أن يكون قادراً على التحدث بنص بسيط و مترابط حول مواضيع مألوفة أو اهتمامات شخصية، ووصف التجارب والأحداث باستخدام جمل قصيرة مترابطة تماما، وتمييز الجمل والعبارات المستخدمة بشكل متكرر وفهمها، وأن يميز الكلمات عند استماعه للمتحدثين ببطء وربط الجمل بشكل مناسب

نبذة تعريفية عن الدورة التدريبية:

هذا هو المستوى **الأول** في اللغة الانجليزية من أصل 12 مستوى ضمن المعيار الاوروبي المرجعي العام، ويشتمل على أساسيات اللغة (الكلمات والقواعد)، وكذلك مهارات اللغة الأربعة (القراءة والكتابة والمحادثة والاستماع)، ويعمل هذا المساق على تغطية الفجوات المعرفية والمهارية التي تناسب هذا المستوى ، ويتم تقديمها للمتعلمين بأسلوب تدريبي بالاعتماد على سلسلة عالمية ضمن ثمانية وحدات، تجمع ما بين متعة التعلم وتحصيل المعرفة واكتساب المهارة اللغوية.
